

Animal Vaccination Camp Organized under TSP on 17th February, 2015

For successful implementation of Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) in the tribal dominated Tapan block of Dakshi Dinajpur district, animal rearing activities have been started besides agricultural activities. For successful animal rearing activities, vaccination of the animals and health checkup are essentially required to save the livestock from future threat of diseases.

Therefore, '*Awareness cum Vaccination Camp*' was organized on 17th February, 2015 at Hazrabari, Tapan block by ICAR-Central Research Institute for Jute and Allied Fibres in collaboration with Dakshin Chakbhabani Rural Awareness Society (DCRAS) with technical knowledge & direct assistance from Dr. Chandrakanta Jana, SMS (AH & VS), KVK, Burdwan. In the vaccination camp, 90 families approached and 184 goats were vaccinated; and another 20 goats were treated for other diseases. Mr. Anjan Kumar Saha, Livestock Development Assistant (LDA), Mr. Satyen Mandal, LDA of Dakshin Dinajpur and Mr. Ananda Kumar Roy, Prani Bandhu, Gurail area of Tapan block assisted Dr. Chandrakanta Jana for successfully vaccinating the goats and convincing the tribal and other villagers about the health of goats and other livestock.
