Sub:- Observance of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2016 in ICAR-CRIJAF HQs and its substations including KVK, BudBud, Burdwan.


Sir,

With reference to your letter no. 51-2/2016-Vig-I dated 27.10.16 regarding observance of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2016 from 31st October, 2016 to 05th November, 2016 and as per the directives of Central Vigilance Commission, New Delhi vide circular dated 19.09.16 and 23.09.16, the following points are submitted for information please.

1. The week started with the pledge of vigilance by all members of the staff – Scientists, Technical, Administrative and Skilled Support Staff personnel in front of the Institute main building at 11 AM on 31.10.16, administered by Dr. P. G. Karmakar, Director, ICAR-CRIJAF. He welcomed the gathering and explained the purpose of Vigilance Awareness Week and the steps taken by the Central Vigilance Commission towards curbing the corruption.

The week was observed in four different substations - Central Seed Research Station for Jute and Allied Fibres, BudBud, Burdwan, WB, Sisal Research Station, Bamra, Odisha, Ramie Research Station, Sorbhog, Assam, Sunhemp Research Station, Pratapgarh, UP and Krishi Vigyan Kendra, BudBud, Burdwan with due diligence. The pledge was administered by the respective Scientist Incharges to the staff posted in those places. Later there were discussions on this year's theme of Vigilance Awareness Week. Besides the postures related to the bad effect of corruption and the necessity of vigilance and the integrity were prepared and pasted at strategic spots.
3. In the Headquarters, some innovative slogans, coined in English and Hindi were printed in poster form and pasted in various places of the Institute and distributed in various sections. A panel discussion has been organised on this year's theme "Public participation in promoting integrity and eradicating corruption" in presence of Dr. P. G. Karmakar, Director, ICAR-CRIJAF, Dr. S. Satpathy, Vigilance Officer, ICAR-CRIJAF, Divisional Heads/Section Incharges and the staff of the Institute. A debate competition and essay writing were held on the theme "Public participation in promoting integrity and eradicating corruption" and the staffs enthusiastically participated in this event. A panel of Pr. Scientists judged the participants for selecting the prize winners. On 05.11.16, the closing ceremony of Vigilance Awareness Week was organised in the Institute Auditorium. Director alongwith all the senior officials of the Institute expressed their views regarding this year's theme of Vigilance Awareness Week. The winners of different competitions (Essay writing and Debate) were awarded by the Director.
