

## About ICAR- CRIJAF

ICAR-Central Research Institute for Jute and Allied Fibres (ICAR-CRIJAF), erstwhile known as Jute Agricultural Research Institute (JARI), is a premier institute conducting research on jute & allied fibre crops. The institute focuses on six natural fibre crops viz., Jute, Mesta, Sunnhemp, Ramie, Sisal, and Flax.

## How to Reach

ICAR-CRIJAF is situated at Nilganj, Barrackpore, West Bengal (6.0 km from Barrackpore Railway Station) and about 20 km from Dum Dum Airport (NSC Bose International Airport). It is well connected by rail, air and roadways to different parts of the country. Participants travelling by train should alight at Howrah/Sealdah/Kolkata railway station, from where local train can be availed to reach Barrackpore railway station. The participants are advised to make their return journey reservations in advance before leaving for Barrackpore. The climate is moderate during the month of September, humid with occasional rains.


## Background

The ICAR-CRIJAF primarily deals with research on jute and allied fibre crops in India with a responsibility of developing new varieties and technologies for benefiting farmers. Recent technologies starting from production to post-harvest have impeccable impact on the quality of research. In this regard, the role of technical personnel is critical in proper generation and recording of experimental data based on which further scientific interpretations are made. Hence upgrading the skills of the technical personnel and awareness on the cutting edge technologies is highly necessary. The prime objective of the training programme is to provide hands on training for proper handling of laboratory equipment and get acquainted with other laboratory procedures in order to generate accurate data and their systematic recording.

## Date and Duration

The duration of the training programme will be of 7 days (19-26 September, 2019). The participants are expected to arrive at ICAR-CRIJAF, Barrackpore latest by the morning of 19/09/2019 and can leave after 17.00 hrs on 26/09/2019.

## Eligibility

Participants in the cadre of Technician or Senior Technician or Technical Assistant or equivalent and above from ICAR institutes and Agricultural Universities are eligible for this training. The number of participants will be limited to fifteen (15) only.

## Travel, Boarding and Lodging

Boarding and lodging for non-ICAR participants will be provided by ICAR-CRIJAF at guest house. TA/DA of the participants should be borne by the sponsoring institute. ICAR-CRIJAF will not provide any TA/DA. **Applicants coming from outside NARS system are required to pay a registration fee of Rs. 500/- through electronic payment to the following account ICAR Unit, Acc. No. 10391779335, IFSC Code: SBIN0014045, MICR Code 700002444, State Bank of India, Branch Nilgunj).**

The selected participants will be provided accommodation in the institute guest house on payment of boarding charges. Food expenses will borne by the organizers as ICAR norms. Local participants are not eligible for boarding and lodging. However, local hospitality i.e. working lunch, intersession tea will be provided to them. Participants are requested not to bring family members with them, as the institute has limited guest house facilities.
